The Children & Young People's Strategic Partnership (CYPSP) aims to improve outcomes for children and young people by working together with key services and organisations in Northern Ireland. The Education Authority is an active member of this and contributes to it's strategic and operational plans.

We have 6 Locality Planning Groups (LPG's) in the Southern area to form local partnerships to share information and address unmet need.
