Rosie's Trust has 150+ highly-trained volunteers. Our volunteer teams care for our beneficiaries' pets in their homes when they are no longer able to do so, helping maintain that very special bond between people and their pets.

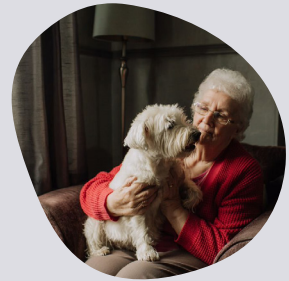
